VINO ESPAÑOL

White

- 11 **Borsao Blanco Macabeo 2010**, £ 15
Campo de Borja
Fresh, lightly savoury nose of peach, lemon and fennel. Broad, textural palate with a clean and fruity finish.
- 13 **Joan Sarda Chardonnay 2009**, Penedés 18
Aromatic intensity marked by exquisite floral notes against a fruity backdrop. It is powerful and dense on the palate, with an excellent structure. Superb Spanish white.
- 24 **Prado Rey Blanco 2010**, Do Rueda 20
Excellent intense aromas of exotic fruit, full with a complex dry finish.
- 25 **Palacio de Bornos 2010**, Do Rueda 21
The wine has a straw-like yellow colour with steel and green hues. It has aromatic fruity notes with anise and minerals, typical of this grape. This is a well structured wine with soft, dense mouth feel, good length and distinctive bouquet
- 15 **Albarino Orballo 2010**, Do Rueda 25
Aromatic and freshly fruited full bodied white. Excellent with tapas.
- 17 **K Naia 2010**, Do Rueda 25
A first vintage of Verdejo, Viura and Sauvignon. Aromatic aromas of opulent tropical fruit, passion fruit, kiwi and guava. Racy acidity with long finish.
- 26 **Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2010**, Do Rueda 25
Typical gooseberry aromas, very smooth with a crisp acidity.
- 27 **Muga Blanco 2010**, Rioja 25
90% Viura and 10% Malvasia, intense with a complex bouquet, good structure and elegant finish.
- 20 **Macia Batle Blanc de Blanc 2009**, Mallorca 30
An elegant and flavoursome white from this highly regarded Mallorcan producer. This predominantly Prensal Blanc wine makes a great alternative to the 'usual suspect' grape. A pronounced ripe peach-skin nose and lively fruit on the palate with hints of honey and pineapple.

Rosé

- 40 **Borsao Rosado Garnacha 2010**, £ 15
Campo de Borja
Soft and balanced, strawberry jam notes and fresh acidity. Superb house rosé.

Red

- 50 **Borsao Tinto Garnacha 2010**, £ 15
Campo de Borja
Juicy bramble fruit and fresh redcurrants. Soft tannins, good acidity with a hint of spiciness.
- 73 **López de Haro Tempranillo 2009**, Rioja 17
100% tempranillo grapes from Rioja, elegant soft fruit and silky finish.
- 53 **Rocamar Tempranillo Vintage 2009**, Rioja 19
Dark cherry red wine with an intense bouquet with mild clove accents and notes of leather. Flavourful, alive and distinguished palate.
- 74 **Prado Rey Roble 2009**, Ribera del Duero 24
Tinta fina, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot give complex aromas and a long finish.
- 56 **Artesa Rioja Crianza D.O.C 2008**, Rioja 24
A soft mature oak-aged Rioja with aromas of berry fruit and vanilla.
- 85 **Joan Sarda Cabernet Sauvignon**, Penedés 24
An intense dark cherry red, it is complex and elegant with an extraordinary wealth of ripe fruit aromas.
- 59 **Macia Batle Crianza Binissalem 2007**, Mallorca 35
Proof that Mallorca can produce excellent wine. Powerful and spicy aromas of red and black fruit. A rich, smooth, supple palate, juicy and beautifully balanced, with layers of tobacco, coffee, bitter chocolate and liquorice.
- 76 **Muga Tinto Reserva 2007**, Rioja 35
A blend of Tempranillo, Garnacha, Mazuelo and Graciano grapes result in a well balanced, lively and shap wine with a nice long finish.
- 77 **Prado Rey Reserva 2005**, Ribera del Duero 45
Tinta fina, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot give a complex structure, elegant soft tannins and a long silky finish.
- 63 **Monte Real Gran Reserva 2001**, Rioja 55
Ochre red with a developed bouquet. Opulent palate with good body and balanced tannins and acidity. Exceptional length.

Dessert Wine

- 99 **Señorio de Sarnia, Moscatel 2007**, £ 16
Ribera Baja de Navarre
Golden yellow colour. Clean, clear and bright. Intense and complex nose (characteristic of the varietal), ample and sweet in the mouth. Lengthy finish showing raisin, peach and honey characters, the aromatic and fruity essence of the Ribera Baja of Navarre.

| This single vineyard, single domaine white burgundy is rich and classy with a hint of toasty oak. | |

| The Mersault has rich green-gold colour and heady, lightly oaky but seductive nutty bouquet. The palate is pretty fat and buttery but cut with toasty hazlenut flavours and long mineral balance. | |

| Intense and pleasantly fruity nose. Fresh and well balanced flavour is followed by a pleasantly bitterish aftertaste. | |
| 54 Marilyn Merlot, France | 20 |
| Fine, supple & intensely satisfying Merlot from Bordeaux. Named after a prominent French restaurateur. | |
| 55 Ramale DOC 2006, Italy* | 20 |
| 100% Nebbiolo Dried soft tannins with low acidity. | |
| 75 Kudu Ridge Mountain Red 2003, South Africa | 24 |
| Ripe blackcurrant and plum flavours on the nose, with hints of peppery, smoky flavours on the palate. Medium bodied wine that was aged in french oak barrels for 14 months. | |
| 83 Colline Novaresi D.O.C. Vespolina | 27 |
| MARETTA 2008, Italy | |
| Deep ruby colour. Sweet nougat, cranberry tart, and light cedar aromas follow through on a breezy entry to a dryish light-to-medium body with accents of roasted nuts and chalk. Finishes with a tangy, pithy fade. | |
| 57 Fleurie La Mondone 2010, France | 28 |
| Heady perfume of pressed cherries, irises and peonies and luscious fruit followed by a gentle note of red spice. Top light Burgundy. | |
| 58 Adoro Red Blend 2005, South Africa | 30 |
| Syrah, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon are sourced from the best vineyards in the Cape to provide for a full bodied, diverse and complex top quality red. | |
| 60 Ghemme DOCG, Italy* | 35 |
| The same wine as the 2004 but Alessandro left the wine for a further four years resulting in softer tannins. It is a split decision which is better? | |
| 62 Gattinara DOCG 2005, Italy* | 35 |
| 100% Nebbiolo grape from the same vineyard as the Ghemme, but in the other valley. Soft and silky with a full structure and an amazing finish. | |
| 65 Pomerol Ch La Croix de Gay 2004, France | 40 |
| Beautiful menthol, cherry, smoky nose out there. Very juicy palate, dark chocolate, pure red fruits & a touch of leather, great tannins and succulent fruits. What a beauty. | |
| 66 Haut Medoc Chateau La Tour Carnet 2004, France | 40 |
| Extremely dark black/crimson. Some glimpses of black plum and cherry fruit. Profound, deep, solid character in the mouth, full body and a huge finish of fruit, coffee and dark oak. Lots of power & compact muscularity. | |

| Very dark crimson. with a red fruit appeal. Crushed raspberry and very bright cherry aromas, against a background of cedar spice. On the palate fine, rich, ripe fruit and masses of grip and tannic extract. Medium-bodied, with a sweetness to the fruit, before that tannic and cherry acid structure clamps. | |
| 67 Chateau Margaux du Tertre 2004, France | 45 |
| Oak rather dominant in the nose but the slightly more modest classy stuff. In the mouth smooth, with plenty of body but not heavy. Sappy dark, black cabernet fruit, hearty finish. | |
| 70 St Emilion Grand Cru La Couspaunde 2004, France | 60 |
| Very earthy, very funky (in a good way). Some sweet fruits on the nose. Palate is very smooth with well integrated tannins that provide a bit of a kick at the finish. | |
| 68 Graves Rouge Heritage 2001, France | 68 |
| Ripe fruit at harvest time allows a strong bouquet, full of character with a deep, intense colour that takes on a brick-red tinge. | |
| 69 Pomerol Chateau La Conseillante 2004, France | 70 |
| Château La Conseillante is sublime in great vintages. A classic, great Pomerol. This attractive, complex, and elegant wine has a wonderful silky texture. | |
| 71 Pomerol Chateau L'Evangile 2004, France | 90 |
| A big wine with considerable tannins, but they are integrated and there is considerable fruit to provide balance. Very good mouth feel followed by an amazing finish. | |
| 72 St Emilion Grand Cru Les Asteries 2004, France | 110 |
| Youthful, intense purple appearance. Soft, plummy nose, with vanilla notes too. A wealth of supple red fruits. | |

| The nose is fragrant, open and lively, leading into outstanding quality on the palate. The wine has fruit intensity, with its own, exciting mineral character, finishing fresh, rich and very long | |
| 78 Hospices de Beaune 1er Cru, France | 60 |
| This is rich, purple-red in colour, with very fruity, elegant aromas, including kirsch. The wine has impressive structure and notable fruit intensity, combining total ripeness with superb, fresh after taste in perfect harmony | |
| 79 Hospice de Beaune Pommard, France | 60 |
| Colour is medium red-purple, the nose being ripe, with freshness. On the palate, a full start leads into a middle-palate with stuffing, and a rich, gently tannic, beautiful farewell. | |
| 80 Hospices de Beaune Volnay 1er Cru, France | 60 |
| Strikingly deep purple-red, with fresh, black fruits aromas. On the palate, this is fleshy and succulent, with strikingly concentrated fruitiness, allied to creamy texture, mouth-filling, lovely tannins, and real finesse on the finish | |
